DAY 1: MARRAKECH

On arrival at Marrakech Airport, you will be met by our representative and transferred to your hotel

DÍA 2: OUZOUND FALLS-CASABLANCA We will start the day heading towards the Ouzoud Falls located northeast of Marrakech, and once having reached this natural paradise we will devote out time to enjoy this country's most famous cascades. In the afternoon we will continue towards Casablanca. Rest of the day off.:



DAY 3: CASABLANCA-RABAT-CHEFCHOUEN:

We will set off in the morning to enjoy a panoramic view of the United Nations Square and the exterior of the Mosque Hassan II which stands by the sea. We will continue our journey towards the municipality of Rabat, visiting the Royal Palace, the Hassan Tower and the Mausoleum of Mohamed V and we will end our day in the famous blue village of Chefchaouen.

DAY 4: CHEFCHOUEN MEKNES-FES: Free time in the morning to explore the village of Chefchaouen, famous for its medina painted in white and indigo blue. In the afternoon we will set off for Meknes to visit the magnificent mausoleum of Mulay Ismail adorned with beautiful mosaics and its imposing gate Bab el Mansour. Our itinerary then continues towards Fez



DAY 5: FES This day will be dedicated to discovering the imperial city of Fez; we will begin our visit at the golden gates of the royal palace, and then, from a high point, we will contemplate the great wall which encloses the astonishing ancient medina which we will later explore in order to experience the different sensations that the city has to offer. Along the narrow streets we will discover mosques and madrasas until entering the tanners' quarter where we will witness the leather treatment processes.



DÍA 6: FEZ-MIDELT-DESERT

We will set off for Midelt via Ifrane - also known as the Moroccan Switzerland; we will stop and rest in the forest of Azrou where we will be able to enjoy watching the monkeys play in their natural habitat, among the millenary cedars, and then we will continue our journey through the Middle Atlas Mountains until reaching Midelt. We will then go through the Ziz Valley and its gorges to reach Erfoud, from where we will follow a track leading us to the desert and we will travel among the dunes up to the Kasbah. Overnight stay at the Kasbah



DAY 7: DESERT:

A day reserved for enjoying, revelling and experiencing the desert in its purest form; we will start our day in Hasselabied where we will enter in a palm grove created and looked after by the entire community. We will continue our trip among the dunes and desert tracks passing by Merzouga and we will travel through time when visiting the small village of Khamlia, which is inhabited by nomads from sub-Saharan Africa. Here, we will hear some popular African music Gnawa and the locals will accompany us on a tour of their village. In the evening, we will get on a camel and travel deeper into the heart of the desert and lose ourselves in its immensity with the aim of spending one night under the stars at kHaima, just like the authentic Berber people, with whom we will enjoy their drum music and a typical dinner

DAY 8: DESERT- TODRA-OUARZAZATE:

We will wake up at daybreak to contemplate the stunning sunrise in its purest form and descend through the sea of dunes at Erg Chebbi until reaching the village of Hasselabied; after having breakfast and taking a shower at a hotel we will continue towards Ouarzazate via Rissani, where we will stop to visit its colourful Souk. Our itinerary will continue through the beautiful Todra Gorges until reaching Ouarzazate, where we will stop for the night.



DAY 9: AIT BEN HADDOU MARRAKECH:

We will spend our morning visiting the fortified village of Ait ben Haddou, famous for having been the scene of important films like *Gladiator*, among others; after lunch we will continue our journey through the Atlas mountains to finally reach Marrakech
